

Home of mercy Korat: a shelter for poor dying and abandoned

Project rationale

Sharing Life Foundation Korat has been running a Home Care Project in the city of Korat for four years, according to the spirit of Saint Camillus and in the name of Catholic community, with special support from our Bishop Chusak and local Catholic community.

Camillians and volunteers provide assistance to the needy, the disabled, and the abandoned in Nakhon Ratchasima by regularly visiting once a week 10-15 people of total 159 poor people in the project (year 2023)

Pope Francis spoke to participants at an international interfaith seminar on palliative care, emphasizing the need for those suffering from illness and nearing the end of life to receive hope and courage from good Christian. He said, "They need witnesses of hope from those who care for and stand by them. Caring for the poor sick and the dying is an expression of mercy and respect for the dignity of every person. We all, as members of society, have a duty to love and support the sick and the dying, as well as to support their loved ones with compassion, so that no one is confined, isolated, or forgotten in their time of need."

Several major issues noticed is abandonment, poverty, disability, lack of caregivers and homelessness. When sickness and inability to be self-sufficient became a reality people often live with no dignity in dirty places, no food, no clean cloths, no basic care approximately 10 individuals in the group we visit regularly, face these severe problems, mostly elderly people with no relatives living in makeshift shelters, under bridges, under trees, along canals, and in public dumps.

Sharing for life Korat has taken two abounded into special care at Home for the aged, and supported their expenses, one of whom has since passed away. This initiative significantly improved the lives of two individuals, providing better living conditions, physical care, hygiene, consistent meals, and participation in activities similar to other elderly residents.

Witnessing these changes inspired to launch the "Home of mercy Project" within the compound of the Home for the aged Ratchasima, next to the "laudato sii Garden" to accommodate 15 abandoned to accommodate 15 abandoned elderlies from the Home care Project.



Of course, is also a matter of spending, we cannot as small foundation spend 500 dollars each month for one individual accommodated in a facility for elders. They also do not need such environment.

So, to provide a dignified and quality life we need to build a special shelter to cut costs with cooperation of volunteers, and support from local community.

The project requires also cooperation from local government agencies, local Catholics and good - hearted people to be successful.

Objectives

- 1. To assist the abandoned in Home Care Project, ensuring they have dignity and value.
- To foster volunteerism and the spirit of love and service among Christians and volunteers, creating a compassionate and caring society.
- 3. To secure cooperation from government agencies and the community in supporting project and be involved in the service.
- 4. To provide beneficiaries with a warm, family-like atmosphere.

Target Groups

- 1. The abandoned in Home Care Project in Nakhon Ratchasima.
- 2. Christians and volunteers in the area.

Implementation Methods

- Prepare the construction site for the Home of mercy in the Laudato Si' Garden area. The building will
 be a single-story structure covering 300 square meters, with 14 beds, 4 bathrooms, a storage room,
 and various facilities for the beneficiaries. Male and female will be separated.
- 2. Reach out to Christian and Buddhist groups to recruit volunteers.
- 3. Fundraise to find sponsors and supporters.

Project Duration

The project will be launched and operational within the year 2024.
